# 1. RHYME AND MATCH MAT :

**Objective :** To enhance the child's ability to generate and recognize rhyming words, fostering linguistic creativity and phonetic awareness. Rhyming skills also make learning stories, poems, or songs more engaging and memorable.

**Material :** 6 sets of rhyming words (3 cards per set, e.g., dog, log, frog)

**Method :**

1. Place a working mat on the floor.

Provide the child with a shuffled set of rhyming word cards.

2. The child will spread all the cards on the mat in a random arrangement. They will pick up one card, read the word aloud, and search for two other cards that rhyme with it (e.g., dog, then find log and frog).

Arrange the three rhyming words on the left side of the mat, leaving spaces between each word.

Repeat the process until all six sets of rhyming words are correctly grouped on the left side of the mat.

**LEARNING OUTCOMES:** Ability to recognize and generate rhyming words.  
Improved phonemic awareness and language development  
Enhanced creativity through playful use of rhymes.

## 2. MEGA TRANSPORT PUZZLE:

**Objective:** To develop problem-solving skills  
To improve visual discrimination  
To enhance concentration and patience

**Materials:** Multiple vehicle jigsaw puzzles

**Method:** Spread all puzzle pieces on the mat.  
The child observes shapes and picture parts carefully.  
Sorts pieces belong to each vehicle.  
Arranges and completes each vehicle puzzle correctly.  
Names the vehicles after completing.

**Learning Outcomes:** Children can assemble different vehicle puzzles independently.  
Improved logical thinking and spatial awareness.  
Better focus and task completion skills.

# 3. SPIN -A - COLOUR WHEEL:

**Objective:** To identify and recognize colours  
To develop colour discrimination skills  
To enhance observation and matching abilities.

**Materials:** One colour wheel card  
7 Colour Tablets of each Orange, Yellow, Purple, Red, Black color

**Method:** Introduce the colours on the wheel one by one.  
Encourage the child to name the colour aloud.  
Open the packet slowly.  
Choose one colour family only (example: Red).  
1. Take out all 7 red shades and place them randomly on the mat.  
2. Arrange from Dark to Light  
3. Pick the darkest shade and place it on the left.  
4. Pick the lightest shade and place it on the right.  
5. Now place the remaining shades in between by comparing.  
Adjust the shades until they look smooth and graded.  
Ensure the shades are in perfect sequence (dark → light).

**Refining the Order:**

**Control of Error:** The child can visually see if:  
one shade looks out of place  
the grading is not smooth

No adult correction is needed unless the child asks.

**Extension:** Once one colour is done, repeat with another colour family:  
Orange shades  
Purple shades  
Yellow shades, etc.

**Learning Outcomes:** Child can identify and grade Orange, Yellow, Purple, Red, and Black correctly.  
Improved colour recognition skills.  
Enhanced vocabulary and confidence in grading colours.

# 4. LITTLE EXPLORER LOOK OUT:

**Objective:** To enhance observation skills  
To improve focus and attention  
To develop descriptive language

**Materials:** Toy binoculars

**Method:** Demonstrate how to hold and look through the binoculars.  
Ask the child to observe objects around them.  
Child identifies and names what they see.  
Encourage describing the object (big, small, far, near).

**Learning Outcomes:** Improved concentration and visual focus.  
Enhanced observation skills.  
Better vocabulary and descriptive speaking ability



## 5. LIGHT AND TRACE DISCOVERY:

**Objective:** To develop visual tracking skills  
To improve concentration and focus  
To enhance hand-eye coordination

**Materials:** Child-safe toy laser light

### Method:

The parent switches on the laser light.  
Move the light slowly in different directions (up, down, left, right).  
Child follows the light with eyes or points towards it.  
Practice tracing simple shapes or patterns with the light.

**Learning Outcomes:** Improved eye movement control and tracking ability.  
Better attention span.  
Increased awareness of direction

# 6. HOLI TALE:

**Objective:** To develop children's language skills, confidence in speaking, and understanding of the cultural importance of Holi through storytelling.

**Materials:** 1 big card, pictures of Prahalad and Holika, and 6 story props.

**Method:** The parent or helper will narrate the Holi story to the child again, as the child already knows the story. The child will write numbers (1-6) on the card using the erasable ink pen provided earlier. Then, using the props, the child will retell the story step by step and enjoy the activity.

**Learning Outcomes:** Children improve their vocabulary, expression, and imagination while narrating the story. They also learn about the festival of Holi, develop social interaction skills, and understand moral values such as truth, faith, and the victory of good over evil.
