Handy Tips

Clothes

Road

Show him/her different vehicles (car, cycle, bus, jeep, scooter, rickshaw) on the road.

Railway Station

You go for a holiday by train, point out interesting things like engine, train, railway tracks and coolie etc. at the railway station.

Airport

1. When you are travelling by an aero plane show your child aero planes taking off and landing. Show him/her the airport bus.
2. Point out the parts of the plane – the wings, the cockpit, the tail, the nose etc. Show him/her the pilot and airhostess.
